It is with great enthusiasm that I submit this letter of recommendation on behalf of Dr. Danilo Squatrito. Having worked in a teaching hospital at AOU Careggi, UniFi, I have had opportunity to see many talented medical students over the years. Rarely do I have an opportunity to work with a student as dedicated as Yuliya Yermakova.

Yuliya participated in a 5-month Training Program in the out-patient department (Ambulatorio) in Lupus Clinic. During this program she worked closely with the Lupus Clinic team that is mainly focused on diagnostics and treatment of the following conditions: Systemic Lupus Erythematosus (SLE), Antiphospholipid Syndrome (APS), Behcet Disease, Rheumatoid Arthritis (RA) and Systemic Vasculitis.


During our Program Yuliya Yermakova followed the doctors team and practiced to perform correctly a history and physical examination, develop a problem list, work on differential diagnoses and prescribe the right medication. This task was quite challenging as all the patients presented with a multifaceted symptoms, in a clinical scenario of difficult diagnosis typical of autoimmune systemic diseases. Besides the pathologies that are often met in Clinical Immunology, such as SLE, APS, RA, Behcet Disease, we also worked with patients who appeared to have Cogan's Syndrome, System Sclerosis, Takayasu's Disease, Churg-Strauss syndrome. Other difficult situations were represented by the management of therapy during pregnancy and differential diagnosis of atypical cases.

From the beginning Yuliya was enthusiastic about clinical medicine and very well prepared. She was a conscientious student and showed an excellent wealth of knowledge and a willingness to go beyond the usual role of students, demonstrating a commitment to continuity in caring for the patients. She also was a very motivated and hardworking student and by the end of the rotation was serving in the first year resident role.

She is totally reliable and dependable. Yuliya developed a very good relationship with patients and their families and she was well accepted by other doctors, residents, fellow students and the nursing staff.

In summary, I highly recommend Yuliya Yermakova for residency training in Allergology and Clinical Immunology. I think she will be an outstanding resident and will positively contribute to whatever residency program is able to recruit her.
